Thin books make fake moves easier. On weekends and during off-hours, liquidity and depth shrink, and spreads widen. A single sweep can push price through an obvious level, only to fade on the retest. Kaiko's data showed Bitcoin's weekend share of trading volume slipping to 16% in 2024. This is a sign of thinner books and higher slippage risk.

Grayscale's introduction of staking-enabled funds marks a key milestone shaped by evolving oversight and growing market competition. The US Securities and Exchange Commission issued guidance for crypto ETPs in May 2025, clarifying that certain custodial staking activities may operate within existing securities laws when managed through regulated custodians and transparent structures. This development has eased earlier barriers that prevented ETFs from earning onchain rewards.

Bitcoin, other than being a digital coin, is a payment network with operations processing transactions scattered worldwide.

The surge in institutional interest in BNB has coincided with a rise in the token's price. On Oct. 7, BNB flipped Ripple-backed XRP to become the third-largest cryptocurrency by market capitalization. Less than a week later, on Oct. 13, BNB hit a new all-time high of \$1,370.
