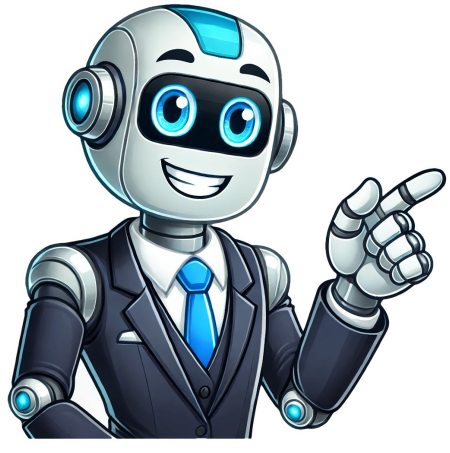

Panelists covered significant labor law decisions of the SJC, shared priorities and updates from the Department of Labor Relations, and led a discussion on trending labor law issues related to retirement and other employee benefits. The 2025 White-Collar Crime Conference took place on Thursday, May 8, 2025. The Boston Bar Associations White-Collar Crime Conference brings together law firm defense counsels, government prosecutors, in-house counsel, judges, and corporate professionals for the signature professional development and networking event for Bostons white-collar crime bar. Bankruptcy professionals and Federal Bankruptcy Court Judges convened on May 15, 2025 to share insights, observations, and analysis on key issues.
