Reconnecting headphones: - Your Bluetooth headphones will automatically reconnect if disconnected. - If not, press the MB button or use your phone's Bluetooth menu to reconnect manually. - To reset factory settings, hold the MFB button for 3 seconds during charging. Troubleshooting common issues: * Mobile phone can't search Bluetooth headphones: - Check if the headphones are turned on (indicator light is on). - Restart both mobile phone and headphones. * Connection or noise issues: - Charge your Bluetooth headphones when power is low. - Ensure there's no blockage between headphones and phone, and maintain a stable signal by keeping them in the same direction. Using Bluetooth headphones with computers: - If your computer has built-in Bluetooth, search for available devices. - If not, use a Bluetooth adapter to connect headphones via software like IVT. Bluetooth pairing password: - The default password is 0000. Most phones will auto-enter this, but some may require manual entry. Maximum distance between Bluetooth headphones and phone or adapter: - The recommended distance is 10 meters for optimal sound quality. - Light noise may occur when reaching the distance limit. Red light not on during charging: - If your headphones haven't been used in a while, charge them for about 30 minutes to reactivate. Tap on the blue "i" icon next to them, then tap Disconnect to unpair your earbuds from your device.
