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Payday 3 dirty ice stealth guide

Payday 3's Dirty Ice heist has a lot more depth than initially meets the eye. The jewelry store seems easy to rob at first but requires some planning and attention to detail. For a stealthy run, start by walking through the front door and taking note of the manager in the back corner. She's only there temporarily and is needed for the Jewelry Workshop side objective, but you can ignore her if you're focusing on the main objectives. The employee of the month sign near the manager might be useful later, so take a moment to memorize the employee number. Since everything is locked up front, you'll need to break in through the back. The left side has a gate that's usually locked and guarded by someone with a Blue keycard, but you can lockpick it or avoid the guard to find the backdoor. However, the backdoor is locked by a QR code, which can be found on a phone either near an NPC or on the ground next to a car. Alternatively, you can try entering through the right side, but this route involves climbing a ledge and fighting a guard for their keycard. If you're trying to do it maskless, we recommend against taking this route. Once inside, make your way to the Manager's Office and snag another phone QR code. Then, read through her emails to find the Basement Code, which is determined by RNG. It could be the manager's employee number, the WiFi password from the Break Room, or a number written in a folder in the VIP Showroom. Depending on what the code is, you'll need to access different areas of the store. If it's the first option, you're good to go. If it's the second, just peek outside and approach the Break Room at the end of the hall. If it's the last option, you'll need to get into the VIP Showroom with a QR code. Be careful on higher difficulties as there might be civilians and cameras in your way. Just read the four-digit number on the table, and you can't grab the jewelry yet because the display cases have an alarm system. There's also a door leading to the Jewelry Workshop, but you'll need to go to the basement first. Now that you've got the Basement Code, it's time to return To access the basement of the store, head to the back and go down the stairs. The keypad is located there, but you won't see it on your HUD - however, if you forget your code, you can still identify it by its fingerprints. Once inside the basement, you'll find some cameras, a camera room with a blue keycard for entry, and a guard. You can navigate through this area as desired and then make your way to the far end of the room where you'll find a power switch for the display case, a Red keycard, and a safe. To complete the main objectives, simply interact with the power switch. The Red keycard will allow access to a vault, while the inside of the safe contains documents needed for the manager-related side objective. After completing the store heist, return to the VIP Showroom and take all the jewelry you can carry. Be aware that there's a lone NPC in the back near a phone and an escape van nearby - consider tying them up before making your move. Avoid the patrolling guard to avoid detection. One additional side objective is to loot the front of the store as well, but be warned, it's very difficult to do so stealthily, especially for solo players. However, if you have the Social Engineering skill and are unmasked, you might be able to pull it off without triggering anything. You'll start with a patrolling guard. To bypass him, access the shop's computer to get one of three codes: the Employee of the Month picture, WiFi password in the break room, or a book in the VIP showroom. Get the code and use it to unlock the basement door. Downstairs, you'll find two key areas: the Camera room, where you can disable security cameras using a radio, and the Utility room with a red keycard, safe, and alarm switch. Grab the keycard and turn off the alarms; consider cracking the safe for extra loot. With the alarms down, you can now rob the jewelry without triggering any alerts. Access the VIP showroom via QR code for an easier way to collect loot. To get more out of your heist, think about coercing the store manager into accessing the Jewelry Workshop near the VIP area. Take a photo of evidence from the basement closet and return it to the manager's office. Then, use that evidence to blackmail the manager over her office phone; she'll come to the back area, allowing you to apprehend her. Bring the manager as a hostage to the Jewelry Workshop, where she can unlock it for you using the biometric scanner. Secure her again and enter the workshop. Inside, clean jewelry with the machine to increase its value in your loot bags. This step offers a higher payout but introduces more risk due to additional steps involved. To access the vault at the back of the store, one player must press the manager's office desk button while the other inserts the red keycard into the vault door access pad simultaneously; timing is crucial here. If playing solo, take the manager to her office and have her press the button. While she does, rush to the vault door and insert the keycard as soon as the button is pressed. Inside the vault, you'll find a rare stone that significantly boosts your final payout. This isn't required for completing the mission but adds substantial value to your heist in Payday 3. With thousands of dollars on the line, the "Dirty Ice" mission in Payday 3 is often completed in under five minutes, showcasing its ease of stealth gameplay. However, the densely populated city surrounding Ashton Fine's store creates a significant detection risk, as passers-by, vehicles, and shoppers could easily spot the players. Fortunately, the mission provides access to a "secret" entrance, allowing players to maintain concealment throughout the operation. This mission can be completed solo or with a team, with no preference for either approach. The key to success lies in moving slowly and acting cautiously, donning masks from the start to avoid NPC contact. Scouting the location before equipping masks is crucial, especially for first-time players. Once inside, navigate towards the side of the building, enter through a window, and locate a bathroom with a potentially hidden phone QR code. Check the manager's office beneath a camera for additional clues. After scanning the phone, access the PC to continue hacking, where you'll find information on one of three secure locations. Locate the basement door code by exploring these options: Employee of the Month frame at the front store, wifi password in the break room, or book in the VIP showroom. Once discovered, follow the alleyway and locate a back entrance to Ashton Fine's building. The heist begins by entering the jeweler's workshop, where a single guard patrols. To proceed, type in the previously obtained code and navigate to an open door (the only one in the room). Enter the room, pull down the handle, and disable the case alarms. Optionally, disable cameras in the camera room to avoid detection. A careful approach is necessary as security guards will immediately start firing upon you. Staying concealed and avoiding detection is crucial. All building alarms are disabled, allowing for a smooth looting process. If spotted by NPCs, instruct them to get on the floor and stash them away. Looting can be completed by accessing the VIP showroom, where five bags of jewelry are available. Once all items have been bagged up, exit the showroom through a specific window before a set of stairs, escaping the building. Be mindful of a security guard patrolling the area when reaching the getaway vehicle. After looting, players should avoid becoming greedy to minimize risk, as this can compromise the entire operation. For successful completion, focus on grabbing what is feasible and exiting without attempting to take everything. This guide provides strategies for completing the "Dirty Ice" heist in Payday 3 using a stealthy approach, including recommended gear and skills. Fingers and Grifter skills make it simpler to handle locks and move around faster during this heist. Bagger (Infiltrator tree), Swift (Escapist tree), and Signal Catch (Hacker tree) are also beneficial if you've unlocked them, especially for speedruns that aim for easy XP and the Smash and Grab achievement. From the start, quickly head to the right-side alleyway of the bank. If you're lucky, you'll spawn directly opposite the alley; otherwise, make your way over there. Put on a mask as soon as you enter the alley and rush past the truck. Find a civilian, grab them, push them behind a box, and tie them up so the patrolling guard won't notice. If there's a phone nearby, collect its QR code. Use lockpicks to open the gate ahead, kill the guard, then answer his radio. If you missed the QR code near the civ, collect it if it's here. Shoot the nearest window (silenced, of course) and jump in. Eliminate the guard and disable the camera as soon as you spot it. Depending on whether you're playing solo or with a friend, your actions will vary for the civilian found here. If you're playing with another player, simply tie them up; if not, grab them and take them to the manager's office before tying them up. Collect a QR code in the manager's office if you didn't get one. Access the computer by pressing the interact button four times before viewing the screen with the location. This will reveal the whereabouts of the code. The whiteboard is located in an open room down the hallway, the storage cabinet is found in an open book on top of a center cabinet in the VIP Showroom in the jewelry store, and the employee of the month picture is in the jewelry store itself. Enter the VIP Showroom by scanning your QR code at the door and shooting the camera. Since you can't loot anything except loose necklaces here yet, only enter the VIP Showroom if your code isn't on the whiteboard. A top tip for speedruns: codes stay the same when a heist is reset, so shaving precious seconds is possible by doing an initial dry run, writing down the code, and voting to reset. Run down to the keypad (directly across from the window you broke) and input the code, then walk into the basement. Neutralize the two cameras and guard here, then enter the door on the far side - if you're extra lucky, this door won't require lockpicking. Collect the red keycard and turn off the power to disable the VIP Showroom's alarms. If you aren't doing a speedrun for easy XP, open the safe and collect the documents to unlock an additional step that increases your payout. Get the civilian in the manager's office and press the red button on the desk. Open the vault door while someone else presses the button, then lockpick the case. Grab your loot and throw it out of the window nearest the van. Next, go to the VIP showroom and either call the manager or grab her to use the optical reader. This opens up the workshop where you can clean the jewelry for more cash. Picklock the glass cases and bag as much jewelry as you like, then throw them into the machine if you have it unlocked.
