This phase provides joint training for Army (MOS 92R), Air Force (AFSC 1P0), and Navy (MOS 773A) personnel. Phase 1 of the 92R10 Parachute Rigger Course currently consists of 25 training days; but will be reduced to 24 training days effective FY25. Must complete Phase 1 prior to attending Phase 2. Before you can become a Soldier, you'll first need to complete a form of initial training—Basic Combat Training(Opens in new window) for enlisted Soldiers and the Basic Officer Leadership Course (BOLC)(Opens in new window) for Army Officers, as well as any additional training your job may require. The Parachute Rigger (RIG) test contains 50 questions, and you are allowed 2 hours to complete it. Active-duty Soldiers and Officers also have ongoing training to keep their skills sharp, so they stay ready for anything. The Army has a waiver process that you can take advantage of to prove you overcame a disqualifying issue that would otherwise prevent you from joining the Army. Soldiers reclassing to 92R must be E4 and below, prior to reporting. This phase provides joint training for Army (MOS 92R), Air Force (AFSC 2T2/1P0/1A2/1A9X1), Navy (MOS 773A), and Marine Corps (MOS 0451) personnel. Must meet course prerequisites. The uniform for training will be their authorized duty uniform and the respective Service Uniform for graduation. Students become proficient in the use of the various technical manuals for rigging airdrop loads. Over the course of your training, you'll learn the skills, knowledge, and discipline needed to become a Soldier. After in-processing, they will report to 710 Adams Ave, BLDG 6025 at 0830 on the start date of class for class enrollment/in-processing. This phase provides instruction to Inter-service enlisted personnel in cargo parachute packing, rigging supplies and equipment for airdrop, to include The 2K Joint Precision Airdrop System (JPADS). DoD civilians will wear appropriate attire such as jeans and polo shirts during training and business casual for graduation. Effective immediately, all phase one classes will start on Tuesday. Flight suits are NOT authorized. The student receives concentrated instruction on the RA-1 in PRO and Flat-packing configurations.
