But this isn't the local influencer's first child. He has a son from the first of his two previous marriages whom he had not met nor spoken to in over a decade. According to Simon, he was given permission to meet the boy, who's now 12, after three years of trying to reassure his ex-wife. [embed] "Today marks a new chapter for my elder son (young one is still in Simongirl's tummy) and my life," Simon, 37, shared in an Instagram post on Nov 25. "Yes, today is the very first time in mine and his entire life that we went out together. It is the first time I've seen him after 11 years." Simon thanked the boy's mother for allowing this to happen. "I'm really grateful his mum had the grace to finally take the first step [to trust] me with my son and giving me this chance [at] redemption. Therefore, today I have the chance to be a father to him," he wrote. Son only recently learned Simon is his dad Speaking to AsiaOne, Simon shared that the reason he had not seen his son for such a long time was due to his incarceration. He had been in prison from 2017 to 2019 for various offences and was in a halfway house from 2019 to 2021. "So, for many years, I wasn't in the right state of mind nor in any position to act upon my roles and responsibilities," said Simon. After leaving the halfway house in 2021, he reached out to his ex-wife to ask for permission to visit his son. But she wouldn't allow it. "I don't blame my ex-wife for not being ready to trust me to handle the responsibilities as a father to my son. Hence, it really took [me] three years to slowly work my way up and prove to her that I've stayed clean and I am filled with positive energy," shared Simon. "I also want to give her huge credit for trusting me with my son. I really just want to make it up to him." Simon also revealed that his son had learned about their relationship only in recent months. His ex-wife had given him permission to follow his son on social media just "half a year ago", shared Simon, and he has been in contact with the boy since then. "When I get to speak with him, I learn more about what his hobbies are. He likes art and computer stuff. But what really makes me happy is that he's really a good boy, very polite and he doesn't have a bad attitude. He can be quite cheeky sometimes," said Simon. A day full of activities During their outing, Simon brought his son bowling, shopping, and to the arcade. Simon shared pictures of himself and the bespectacled boy — who was all smiles — at the different locations, including a sports shop. Another photo taken showed both of them wearing identical Nike shoes. They ended the day with dinner before he sent the child home, described Simon. Besides enjoying each other's company, Simon also got the chance to catch up with his son. "I am grateful to my son for not being mad at me for missing in his entire childhood. He has the biggest heart ever as a kid," said the proud dad. "Today, we chatted a lot on everything about his life. One thing that caught me [sic] was when I ask what's his dream. He said he [wants to] be a police officer. That's exactly what I wanted to be when I was young." No negativity from current wife Simon recently tied the knot with Chloe in July, after proposing to her in March this year. He expressed his appreciation to Chloe for being nothing but understanding towards the situation. "I feel very encouraged and supported by Chloe. She has never once gone against this decision of mine to reconcile with my son," a grateful Simon told us. When Simon met his son for the first time, Chloe also checked in on them. "Around 5pm when I was out with my son, she still texted me to remind me to bring him for dinner and to not play at the arcade until we forgot to eat," he recounted. Previous Next SINGAPORE - After a gruelling 45-hour labour, local content creator Simonboy, whose real name is Simon Khung, and his wife Chloe Eong, also known as Simongirl, welcomed a baby boy. Their son Sunny was born in the early morning of April 9 and both mother and child are well. Khung, 37, posted pictures of the newborn on the same day on his Instagram account, which has more than 97,000 followers. He wrote on behalf of Sunny: "I also want to thank my mummy for enduring for 45 hours till I'm out. I love you, mummy."Khung posted on Instagram Stories that he and Malaysia-born content creator Eong, 33, arrived at the hospital on April 7 at around 9am as Eong went into labour. Sunny was born at around 6am on April 9. Khung included a clip of Eong trembling with contraction pains.The couple, who got married in 2024, named their son Sunny in the hope that he will be happy and cheerful. "We also pray he will be a shining light to the people around him," Khung wrote.He posted on Instagram Stories that Sunny has "one big korkor (older brother) and one jietjie (older sister), forever they will be".The thrice-married Khung has a son from his first marriage, with whom he reunited for the first time in 2024 after 11 years. He also had a daughter, Megan, from his second marriage. She made headlines when she died in 2020 aged four after a year of abuse at the hands of her mother, Khung's former wife Foo Li Ping, and Foo's then boyfriend Wong Shi Xiang.Khung, who last saw Megan in 2017 before he was incarcerated for three years for drug offences, posted an apology to her on April 3, the same day her abusers were handed their sentence. Foo was sentenced to 19 years' jail while Wong was sentenced to 30 years' jail and 17 strokes of the cane.Khung added that "nothing is ever enough to give (him) any good closure".He reflected that it has been five years since Megan's death, and it was "no coincidence" that the sentencing came a week before Eong was due to deliver their first child.He took it as a sign for him to move on, adding: "I know that every ending is a new beginning. Two weeks after their solemnisation at The New Charis Mission halfway house, Simon Khung and Chloe Eong, aka Simonboy and Simongirl, finally exchanged their vows at the Concorde Hotel last night (Jul 19). The 37-year-old TikTok star met his 31-year-old bride on dating app Bumble only three years ago, but according to them, they've waited for this day a long time. The wedding banquet was attended by some 500 guests, with 59 tables sprawled across the ballroom, all adorned with pink and white roses. When 8days.sg first arrived at the ballroom, we saw Simon's groomsmen: Kelvin Tan (Mayiduo), Tommy Wong (Tommy NBCB), Luke Chan, Noah Yap, Derrick T (Panghu), and Ronald Tan stationed at the reception area, greeting friends and ushering guests around the venue. Laughter and lively chatter filled the air and the vibe would carry on well into the night, with guests hopping from table to table to catch up with each other. Seldom do you see so many internet-famous people in one place. Ryan Tan, Nicole Choo, Titus Low, Amy Ang, Deborah and Fabian Gilbert, Bert and Lulu, and SGAG's Xiaoming were just some of the content creators we spotted. The couple unanimously raised Simon's Gucci loafers, with Chloe saying: "You look at his shoe and you look at my shoe. You'd be able to tell who spends more money already." Simon also prepared a surprise for Chloe, singing a heartfelt rendition of Mandarin ballad, Wu Shi Nian Yi Hou. He paused midway through the song to whisper in Chloe's ear, and we would later find out his exact words were: "I love you baby." The couple played the TikTok viral 'wedding shoe game' It was close to 10pm when it came to the most eagerly anticipated part of the night — the speeches. Simon's pal of over 20 years, and member of his Peace Street Productions crew, Panghu, was the first to take the stage. He spoke of the ups and downs of the journey they shared, with the crowd erupting into cheers as he dedicated a short, but powerful speech to his close friend. "I still remember back then, [Simon] was still a young, clean, handsome, one-of-a-kind little boy. 20 years. From doing drugs together, to doing content together. From sharing drug utensils, to sharing our life testimonies together. From fighting in the streets, to fighting [for] our future together. From being a drug addict with only \$50 in your pocket, to [being] my boss in Peace Street Productions. A multi-business owner, Wei Nan (Simon's Chinese name), I'm so proud of you," said Panghu. Luke and Chloe's older sister also gave speeches, as did Simon's elder brother, Wai Yeen. The most moving part of Wai Yeen's speech was when he sought to make amends for failing to be a bigger part of Simon's childhood. He said: "With the six years between us, we were never particularly close. I was a dumb kid then, and I'm not that smart now as well. As a kid, I bullied him relentlessly, not realising the harm it did to him and our relationship. As we grew older, our paths [diverged]. At 15 to 16, he got into some bad company, joined a gang, and spiralled down a path of substance abuse. As I grew older, in our thought) to myself, if I had been a better brother, maybe he wouldn't have gone down that path. So today, Nan, I want to apologise to you for failing to act as an older brother during all those years. For that I'm truly sorry." Simongirl teared up as she heard the heartfelt speeches from their closed ones Then came Simon and Chloe's turn. Chloe, in our humble opinion, gave the best speech of the night. "I'm not someone who talks much, but I'd like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude," she began in Mandarin. Chloe, who grew up in Malaysia, first thanked her parents for giving her the freedom to pursue her dreams from a young age. She also expressed her gratitude towards Simon's parents, her friends, and her wedding party. "Lastly, I want to thank my husband, [the person who] will be by my side every step of the way in the future. Thank you for appearing in my life, for showing me all the things I've never seen, and for letting me experience all the things I didn't get to experience in the past. I chose you, not because I'm past 30, and want to quickly settle down. It's because I want to spend the rest of my life with you. In the future, I hope we'll cherish each other, and the time we get to spend together." "I know we will have fights, and will disagree with each other at times, but I hope we'll never care about who wins or loses, because when you lose, I'll lose with you, and when you're victorious, I'll always be there to share your victory. In poverty and in wealth, and in sickness or health, I'll always be by your side. I will love you, be loyal to you, and protect you forever." Now, who's cutting onions? Simon's speech was equally moving, especially the part where he took the time to honour and thank his stepfather. "He's been in my life ever since I was five," revealed Simon. "I call him uncle. When I told him I wanted to learn swimming, he would come home from work at 5pm sharp every single day to take me swimming. He never missed a day, and I learnt how to swim in two weeks. When I told him I liked Fann Wong, he brought me to Sungei Road to buy photos of Fann Wong. "Today, my mentor told me: "Simon, if you regard him as a father, you should call him 'dad'." So I want to tell him, Pa, thank you for loving me since I was young, and for treating me as a son. You don't have to worry about anything when you grow old, I'll definitely take good care of you," said Simon, all choked up with emotion. He then ended his speech by addressing his bride: "To my beloved wife, we've waited for three years, and finally this day has come. Thank you for your companionship, and for helping me understand what it means to win together during the ups, and to get back on our feet together during the downs. If you ask me if my wife will still be with me if I lose everything today, I can confidently tell you she will not leave me. Because that's where we started. If I lose everything, I will tell you that I will still live my life well, because I am still with the person who means the most to me. "You never looked down on me, even when I only had \$10. You encouraged me to work, you never minded my past, and the fact that I've been to jail. It's because of your unwavering support that I've managed to achieve what I have today. I might not have been the best boyfriend, but I promise to be the best husband." The clock struck 11, and the couple would go on to take pictures with their guests and mingle with their nearest and dearest, all while the alcohol kept flowing, and the conversations continued late into the night.
